Together, participants and the Facilitator(s) investigate life issues, set goals, and create a plan of action to help participants to build a better life for themselves and their families. Community friends, called Encouragers, partner with participants during the **Building the Bridge** workshop and, upon completion, in the optional **Crossing the Bridge** program. They encourage you to build the resources you identify as most needed as you work to reach your goals.

Participants are paid \$10 at each session attended and an additional \$50 upon completion of the workshop with the expectation that follow-up assessments will be completed. Participants may miss a maximum of three sessions, which must be made up with a Facilitator. Class supplies are provided, and a meal is served at each session. Transportation and on-site childcare are available if needed.
